Emergency Immediate Aftermath Donations

– DO NOT DONATE ITEMS THAT ARE NOT LISTED BELOW –

From Garry Maddox:

“Immediate Aftermath” items are usually needed in the weeks to a month after a storm. After that, please focus on the “Long Term” needs as people set up their homes again.

Clean-Up Supplies

- Box knives
- Hammers
- Flat pry bars
- Flat shovels
- Tyvek suits
- Wheelbarrows
- Rubber gloves
- Floor squeegees
- Wheelbarrows
- Large heavy-duty garbage bags
- Hoses
- Mosquito repellent
- Cleaning supplies
- Mops, brooms, buckets, squeegees
- Scoop shovels, rakes
- Safety glasses
- Leather gloves
- Long rubber gloves
- Mechanic type gloves
- Box knives
- Small scrub brushes
- Box fans
- Scoop shovels
- Push brooms

Paper Products

- Toilet paper
- Paper towels

Personal Care Items

- Laundry detergent, fabric softener
 - Dryer sheets
- Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap
 - Deodorant, anti-perspirant
 - Toothpaste, toothbrushes
 - Feminine hygiene products
 - Baby wipes
 - Diapers
 - Adult diapers
- Suntan Lotion SPF 30 or higher
 - New hairbrushes

Perishable Items

All perishable items must be within the date and not expired.

- Baby formula/baby – Must be within date
 - Gatorade/Powerade
- Individually wrapped snack foods with long-shelf life (no expired food)
- Food with long shelf life (no expired food)

(All sizes in original package)
 - New Socks in all sizes

Disaster Long-Term Recovery Donations

From Garry Maddox:

At the beginning of a disaster many people flock to meet the immediate need of those affected. Often towns are overrun with donations & must spend time/manpower finding places to put everything & manage the flow of goods. I would like for us to think a little longer term. Think about what people would need to go back in and set up a house. Think about when you moved into your first home or got married, what were the things that you needed to fill out your home? That said, I want to suggest the following types of new items for you to consider:

- Silverware set 4 or 8 place settings
- Dishes set 4 or 8 place settings
- Drinking cups
- Coffee cups
- Knives
- Potato peeler
- Pizza cutter

- Small hand mixers
- Mixing bowls
